English Learner Academy

Overview


- 57 newcomer students (grades: rising 6-12)
- 3 NUSD Teachers
- 1 full-time consultant from Clark Consulting & Training
- 4 weeks of intensive academic language instruction



English Learner Academy

Academics & Instruction:

- Provide teachers and students with a focused program of applied, grammar-based language teaching.
- Weekly Professional Development sessions after school to enhance and deepen teacher understanding and expertise.
- 10 high-powered methods to develop advanced English language competencies

Social and Emotional Learning & Support Focus:

- Collaboration between EL Coordinator and Special Education Coordinator for Behavioral Health on planning support for students attending Newcomer Academy.
- Worked with teachers to develop trauma-informed class meetings.
- Class meetings incorporated messages of safety, bonding, and developing & practicing coping skills.
- Screened all students in Newcomer Academy for Strengths and Difficulties as well as any symptoms of acute trauma to inform class meetings and staff regarding student needs.

Special Education Extended School Year

Overview



- 2016 Extended School Year (ESY) was located at San Ramon Elementary in 5 different classrooms over the first 4 weeks of summer break
- 66 kids attended from ages 4 to 17
- 5 teachers organized their lessons to focus on IEP goals with support from 6 paraeducators
- 4 high school interns joined staff the early intervention and TK-1 classrooms
- 1 speech pathologist and 1 occupational therapist pushed into all classrooms to support language, social and motor goals
- 1 behaviorist to provide support to students BIP implementation

Special Education Extended School Year

Highlights

- Students from all over Novato and even from outside Novato
- Staff from schools all over Novato and even outside of Novato
- Teachers, SLP and OT worked into classrooms to provide real world lessons on cooking and healthy choices using San Ramon's garden
- With the Olympics ahead, classes learned about athletes, importance of practice and perseverance
- New research-based reward programs, routines and communication tools were implemented and successful


